- 3. Encouragement to report unsafe work activities to your supervisor or Safety Coordinator.
- 4. Please remind team members that we are all Safety Managers and have the authority and responsibility to stop any unsafe work activities

NEW PROJECTS & GROWTH IN 2022



LODI, CALIFORNIA

In 2022, we started farming a new farm located on the California Delta. We planted 1,000 acre in March and started harvesting in July. The advantage to this new farm is a shorter growing season that allowed for different shipping timeframes that would be accommodating to our customers like Frito Lay and In & Out.

LYNDONVILLE, NEW YORK

This new farm project was established in New York to enhance the Bliss seed supply with high-quality, disease free CSS Farms grown seed. The team launched this project in 2022 by growing 240 acres of Snowden and Lamoka seed with hopes to expand in the future.





PASCO BABY POTATOES

Starting in 2021, Pasco grew ciklamen reds and gala yellow baby potatoes for Tasteful Selection. Their first year they started with 280 acres but quickly added 1700 acres this year. The Pasco team has harvested all direct gala potato fields and is working on harvesting storage ciklamen crop and galas.

PRO-HEALTH & HIGGINS, TEXAS

Starting in Dalhart, TX was a joint venture with Pro-Health in growing A-size reds and yellows as well as baby/mini red, yellow and purples. This required an additional 1,000 acres of land in the Texas panhandle, in which we found 600 acres in Higgins, TX.





HOOKS, TX

Starting this year, we explored growing a half pivot of chipping potatoes near Texas/Arkansas/Louisiana border. This new location provided a consistent supply to our customer in the June timeframe.
